Class 1 Fruit/Vegetable

Section: Cut Flower

2. Hydrangea – 3 stems/blooms, any colour

1. Geranium- one plant, unlimited blooms
2. Cactus- any variety

Prizes: 1st \$3.00, 2nd \$2.00, 3rd \$1.00 each category

Section A: 5 years of age and under

1. Print First Name on an 8 ½ x11 inch page
2. Make a caterpillar out of ½ an egg carton
3. Make a display of treasures you have collected from a walk. Use a 10 inch paper plate and fasten the treasures to the plate.

Section B: ages 6 to 8 years of age

1. Make a farm building out of Lego and display on a 6 inch paper plate (fasten to plate)
2. Make an article out of duct tape and display in a resealable bag on a 6 inch paper plate (fasten bag to plate)
3. Make a display of treasures you have collected from a walk. Minimum 6 treasures. Label each treasure. Use a 10 inch paper plate and fasten the treasures to the plate.

Section C: ages 8 to 11 years of age

1. Make a place mat using the theme “Yesterday, Today, Tomorrow” using a piece of Bristol board 8 ½ inches by 11 inches.
2. Make a bracelet using assorted plastic beads
3. Hand drawn first initial on 8 ½ by 11 inch page and decorate using various mediums.
